

Kenneth F. Wallis

Kenneth F. Wallis is Emeritus Professor of Econometrics at the University of Warwick. He was educated at Manchester University and Stanford University. He held the Chair of Econometrics at Warwick from 1977 to 2001; previously he taught at the London School of Economics. Elected a Fellow of the Econometric Society in 1975, he served as Co-Editor of its journal, *Econometrica*, from 1977 to 1983, and as Program Co-Chair of its Seventh World Congress, held in Tokyo in 1995. He is the author of two econometrics textbooks and many research articles in the areas of macroeconomic modelling, statistical time series analysis, and the interface between them. He was Director of the ESRC Macroeconomic Modelling Bureau, a unique model comparison project established at Warwick by the Economic and Social Research Council, throughout its existence (1983-99). He is a Fellow of the British Academy and the International Institute of Forecasters, and was awarded an honorary doctorate by the University of Groningen in 1999.
